



THE WDSF WORLD GAMES' QUALIFICATION SYSTEM FOR STANDARD AND LATIN DISCIPLINES

1. General Structure

The WDSF Qualification System for 2025 The World Games consists of two (2) levels: national and international.

National Level

To take part in the WDSF World Games' Qualification System, Adult couples will need to be ranked in WDSF National Ranking List and compete in at least one (1) WDSF competition.

International Level

Adult and PD Couples will compete together in the International/Continental Qualifier.

Each NMB will nominate Adult couples to participate in International/Continental Qualifier according to their WDSF National Ranking List and the quota established by WDSF for each NMB.

PD Couples may participate directly in International/Continental Qualifier without any quota restriction.

2. WDSF National Ranking List

The WDSF National Ranking List in the Adult age category is determined at the sole discretion of each WDSF National Member Body.

Each NMB will be responsible to upload the National Ranking List to the WDSF website no later than September 1st, 2024, and under following conditions:

- All athletes have "active" status of their WDSF License
- All Adult couples competed in at least one (1) WDSF competition.

3. International/Continental Qualifier

Quota construction

Adult couples' participation quota in the WDSF International/Continental Qualifier is determined by the WDSF for each National Member Body in accordance with the number of WDSF athletes registered by the National Member Body for the period of the 2023 calendar year.

Quota announcement

The list of quotas for International/Continental Qualifier for each WDSF National Member Body will be published on the WDSF website.

PD Athletes

All PD couples are allowed to participate directly in the WDSF International/Continental Qualifier without needing to be ranked in the WDSF National Ranking List. PD couples will not be counted as part of National Quota for International/Continental Qualifier.











4. The World Games

Quota per continent

Quota per continent will be calculated by the WDSF according to the number of athletes 'active licenses and competitions held on each continent in 2023.

Eligibility/Continental TWG Qualification Ranking List (TWGQRL)

To be eligible to participate in The World Games the couple must be ranked on the Continental The World Games Qualification Ranking List.

Calculation of the Continental TWG Qualification Ranking List will be based on the:

- Position in WDSF World Ranking List PD or Amateur and
- Position in International/Continental Qualifier

Total TWG Quota places

Twenty-four (24) couples per discipline will be eligible to participate in 2025 TWG based on the combined results of the International/Continental Qualifier and the WDSF World Ranking System, as of 1st April 2025.

5. Miscellaneous

Active License

To ensure the compliance of the code of Ethics, Anti-Doping regulations and other important WDSF Rules and Regulations, all Athletes and Officials will only be allowed to participate in WDSF TWG Qualification System if they have "active" status of their WDSF license.

Passports and Nationality

At least one component of the couple will have to present valid passport proving Nationality of the representing NMB in The World Games. *
